### **JOB STATEMENT/PURPOSE:**

The Maintenance Intern worker will work with the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent to be exposed to all facets of our maintenance program, including turf management, machinery and irrigation practices.

### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Cares for the putting greens and tees by watering, reseeding, manicuring, topdressing and mowing using specialized (walking and riding) equipment.
- Implementation of cultural practices.
- Irrigation troubleshooting, repair and maintenance.
- Cares for sand traps, fairways, and roughs by raking, watering, edging, spiking, aerifying, weeding, and manicuring.
- Assist in scheduling daily jobs for maintenance crew.
- Operate machinery such as greens mowers, sand trap rakes and other equipment in a safe and careful manner.
